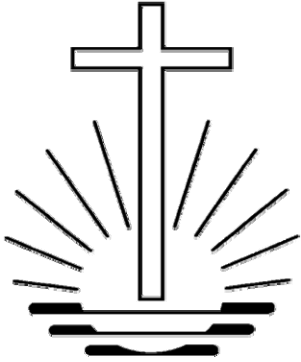

Soothing tranquility, rest for your soul, pure air so we can breathe deeply, herbs grow by mineral springs helps our soul to recover and we have a magnificent view.

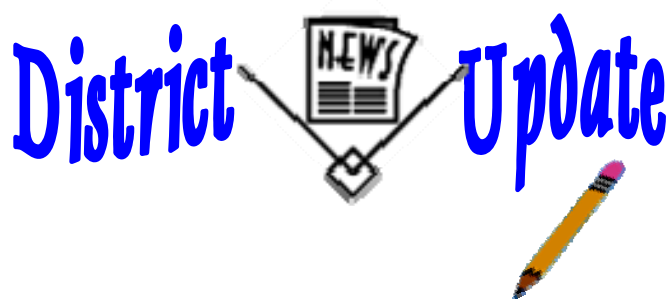

QUEZON NORTH RELIEF OPERATIONS

Some 30 young people volunteered in the Quezon North relief operations where 5 congregations were affected by landslides and flash flood. Our members lost their livelihood and it will took one (1) year to recover. The hard hit was in Talisay and Banugao congregations. Their houses and all of their belongings are gone. No lives are claimed with our members. Our prayers are heard but 1,000 died according to news reports.

Our members told us they were able to move out in the morning while the water starts to rise up. In the evening the water submerged the houses and washed out with a raging sound from the mountain an explosion then rocks, soil and thousand logs came down. Six (6) New Apostolic families are left homeless, clothless, shocked of what

happened. Their land is gone, it transformed into a deserted river.

The youth distributed the relief goods with compassion. Every donation given was heart touching. Our members are in tears just by seeing us. They are praying that we come. Every location divine service is conducted. Some gave a feedback saying that many other religious organizations came too, but it is only the New Apostolic Church who gave a comfort in the divine services.

Some of the relief goods are also given to non-new apostolics. Many inactive members identified themselves during the relief operations. District Evangelist Melencio Bringas took note of their locations.

The youth joyfully carry in their shoulders the relief goods on broken bridges crossing the river, while its raining, and tired everybody went home had felt differently inside. It is in giving love which will truly make you happy.

Doing so we also love Him (God), remember and think of Him and do everything to make Him happy.

The members in Quezon North would like to thank all of the relief goods they received and the love that was shown, which make them feel its wonderful to be a New Apostolic child of God.
