

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Editorial

My dear youth,

I would like to make a follow-up on my editorial issue last month May 2006 regarding the new baptismal concept.

What is new is that we recognize the water baptism administered in other Christian Churches.

As we have learned during Ascension Day service that "You shall be

witnesses of Me..." (Acts 1: 8), these words indicate that we should also be 'witnesses' of Christ by making the glad tidings known and dedicate our whole life to Christ.

We are called today as New Apostolic Christians to testify to all those who are baptized by water that they had made the first step to renewal in the Holy Spirit and to receive a full life and full freedom they need to receive the Holy Spirit in the Holy Sealing.

How? If they come to believe in our 10 articles of faith, we can say that by heart they are already new apostolic. A public declaration of this belief is done during adoption conducted by a minister of Christ.

In this respect, baptism with water is followed by the baptism of the spirit. A soul who attends regularly the divine services will learn and

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understand the offer of God's love. And He pours out His love to a believing soul through the act of the baptism of the spirit the Holy Sealing (Romans 5: 5).

When a believer receives the sacrament of the Holy Sealing Jesus Christ registers him in the Book of Life of the Lamb. Holy Sealing has special significance for our future, because it is closely related with the future hope of those living in the end time: "And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption (Ephesians 4: 30).

When we concern ourselves about the soul's salvation and redemption of many other people, we will be compelled to testify of the truth. There is no other salvation in which we can be saved on the day of Christ return but the salvation for the bride of Christ. Yes God's will that all men will be saved and come to the knowledge of the truth. It is very clear now to us that God has different periods of salvation. There is salvation for the bride of Christ, for the martyrs, for those who come to believe in the 1,000 years kingdom of peace, and on the Day of Judgment day. We are called to partake in the wedding feast of the lamb as a bride of Christ.

This is our hope and our longing. May we find the last souls in this short period time of grace in which we live.
