**Dear Apostle Hebeisen,**

***It is my heart's wish that I could attend all divine services, be active in the choir and orchestra, and be active in the circle of our youth, but my schooling always conflicts with our church activities. I'm not happy anymore, what shall I do?***

*Yes there are such periods in life where it is just not possible to follow ones hearts desire.. Many people have professions which keep them away from church activities.*

*In our life we want to try to plan accordingly and give the moments in God's house priority. Often, that brings about a sacrifice and some-times tough decisions are to be made.*

*Now there are also the situations we cannot control. The Heavenly Father knows them. In case of schooling this might be only temporary, when it comes to ones profession and livelihood it is already more complicated. "ask and you will be given, seek and you find" God knows the hearts desire and will also make the impossible possible, even though some patience is needed. Anyway always study all options in school and work plans.*

*Also a life's partner who does not share our faith can be a hindrance to be part of many activities in church. That is why one should be very carefully examine his heart and set the priorities right before it is too late.*

*Some years ago the celebration of Holy Communion in Midweek-Services was introduced exactly to give all those a chance who cannot attend Sunday Services. Officiants usually pray in opening prayers for those who cannot be present. That they shall also be connected to the blessing. Think of this and bind your faith to it.*

*Take it as an experience of how important Divine Services are. Later when you have a choice you will be able to make appropriate decisions easier.*
