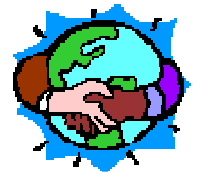

I am a youth, working here in metro manila. I am just afraid and confuse. I have a relationship with a man who are separated with his wife and have 2 children. I know from the beginning that he is married, I love him, and he also promises that I will be happy with him. Is it a sin if I will marry him? Is it allowed in our church if I will ask a marriage blessing? (If in case I will say yes to him). Thank you very much for your advice.

First of all let me get something straight.

You cannot marry this man.

The Philippines does not know legal divorce and separation does not qualify for re-marriage nor a blessing in the church.

Then do some soul searching what this relationship is all about. What do you expect from it, what does he expect. Think of the wife and the 2 children who probably are in distress because of this situation. Just think of it, if you would be that wife, how would you feel?

From my experience in soul care this promise of being happy will never be fulfilled under such circumstances.

*My advice is **SAY NO TO HIM.***
